

2009 2nd Half Playoff Rules

- 1) **Two volunteers from each team to work the Snack Stand.**
- 2) **Visiting Team responsible for scorebook, Home Team: Announcer/Scoreboard**
- 3) **Both teams work together to get complete pre and post-game field maintenance.**
- 4) Pitching: 7 innings total any two games. One pitch equals one innings. Eligibility to be reviewed prior to start of each game. In the event of illegal pitcher, that pitcher is removed immediately from the mound.
- 5) No Balk Warning.
- 6) Ten (10) Run Rule is in effect, any team head by ten or more runs after 4 1/2 (Home team) or 5 innings (Visitors) is the Winner.
- 7) **Game is official after 4 ½ (Home Team Winning) or 5 innings**
- 8) Game called on darkness after game becoming official reverts back to last completed full inning. In the event that the reverting back results in a tie game, the game will be frozen as is and resumed at the frozen point the next day, before next the scheduled game.
- 9) Starters can re-enter only once, in the same spot in the line-up they previously occupied. Each player must play 2 defensive innings and get one at bat. This is a departure from what we've been doing but I think it's appropriate at this point. Let me know if you need help understanding how the substitution process works as it relates to your line up card and reporting obligation.
- 11) REPORT ALL SUBSTITUTIONS TO THE PRESS BOX PRIOR TO MAKING THE SUBSTITUTION. BATTING OUT OF ORDER WILL NOW BE INFORCEABLE.
- 12) Coin flip to determine home and away.
- 13) **Light Blue Bags:** After your 2nd loss, have the players hand in their Jerseys. Return Jerseys and gear to Pete Loef, Chris Lynch or Pat Tobin. There will be light blue bags placed in each dugout of the loser bracket games. **Managers: Make sure all parents understand this. Kids should have an undershirt ready. This part of the business is very time consuming for Pat, Pete and myself. Please help us out here !!!**
